**That's why a licence is required**

**Section 15 of the law governing copyrights ("Urheberrechtsgesetz") of 9 Sept.1965 requires that the approval of GEMA (Gesellschaft für musikalische Aufführungs- und mechanische Vervielfältigungsrechte) be obtained for any music performance at the exhibition stand.**

You can very easily obtain a licence to use music legally: either our customer adviser has already visited you and will then complete all the formalities on your behalf. Or you ring the GEMA regional office which is responsible for your company's head office or place of residence.

Our customer advisers will then discuss with you all the details of your planned music use. In both cases you will receive a contract offer which you can examine at your leisure.

Once you have signed and returned the contract and paid the agreed fee, you will own your personal licence. The fees for the most common forms of music use can be calculated and compared with non-binding effect in our online tariff calculator – even without registration.
